Mastrojanni Relais is situated in **Castelnuovo dell'Abate**, a small settlement located at approximately 389 meters above the sea level in the municipality of **Montalcino**, in the Val d'Orcia. Perched on top of a hill, the medieval village overlooks the famous Abbey of Sant' Antimo and also features some remnants of walls erected by Siena in 1360.

Restored and reopened in 2019, this is a destination designed for those seeking to immerse in the natural rhythms of an ancient Tuscan estate.

We are right in the middle of a wine country, home of Italy's finest appellations: **Brunello di Montalcino**.

Since 1975, Mastrojanni has been a historic winery crafting wines that embody the essence of our unique terroir and the patience required to create iconic vintages. Under the vision of *Francesco Illy*, since 2022, we have now embraced organic farming and is transitioning to biodynamic practices.

Castelnuovo dell'Abate



Just a few minutes drive from our resort, you will find **Castelnuovo dell'Abate**, a small and charming medieval village in the municipality of Montalcino, in the beautiful Val d'Orcia.

It originated as a fortification for the nearby **Abbey of Sant'Antimo**, and its name recalls the abbot of the abbey who decided to build it in the medieval era on a defensible rocky outcrop. Don't miss the Church of Saints Philip and James, a simple religious building made of travertine blocks in Romanesque style. Inside, there are some fine frescoes from the 16th century.

Today, the village enjoys great vitality thanks to its historical inhabitants and the many young people who live there.

Just a short distance from Castelnuovo dell'Abate stands **the Abbey of Sant'Antimo**, inhabited over the centuries by Benedictine monks and founded, according to legend, by Emperor Charlemagne. The church, built in the 12th century, is considered one of the masterpieces of medieval architecture. Its walls are not only a magnificent monument but also guardians and witnesses of Benedictine monastic spirituality.

Montalcino



Montalcino is a beautiful historical town renowned worldwide for the production of **Brunello di Montalcino**. The medieval village has been unchanged since the 16th century and still, today offers a succession of winding hills and panoramic white roads.

Montalcino is not just wine, it's also culture. The center is dominated by **the fortress** built in 1361 to mark Siena's rule over the town. The panorama from the fortress includes views of Mount Amiata, and the Crete Senesi, and stretches across the entire Val d'Orcia to the hills of Maremma. The fortress often becomes the ideal setting for festivals, events, and concerts, such as the famous Jazz & Wine Festival in July.

Another attraction in Montalcino is the narrow and long tower of the **Palazzo dei Priori**, the seat of the Municipality, overlooking the main square Piazza del Popolo, with its beautiful Gothic loggia. Also must-visit are the churches of Sant'Agostino and Sant'Egidio.

Not to be missed is **the Civic and Diocesan Museum of Sacred Art**, which exhibits religious paintings by **Sano di Pietro, Simone Martini, Ambrogio Lorenzetti**, and sculptures, and the Brunello Museum, which traces the history of this worldwide known wine.

Pienza & Bagno Vignoni



PIENZA

Once a medieval city, it was demolished and rebuilt in the Renaissance style by **Pope Pius II**. **The Pienza Cathedral** houses important and remarkable paintings by the most renowned artists of the time. **The Pieve di Corsignano** is a beautiful and romantic small church just a few minutes walk from the center of Pienza.

To the right of the Cathedral stands **the Palazzo Piccolomini**.

Heading towards Bagno Vignoni, you will encounter signs leading to the **Chapel of the Madonna di Vitaleta**, isolated and surrounded by a few cypress trees it is one of the iconic symbols of Val d'Orcia.

BAGNO VIGNONI

The heart of the village of Bagno Vignoni is its square, **Piazza delle Sorgenti**, featuring a large thermal water basin at 52° Celsius. It is a medieval pool built in the 1500s and is surrounded by Renaissance buildings, creating a timeless atmosphere.
